*Rackless Kazi DJ RESIDENCY is a platform for young women between the ages 18 to 35 years who are DJs, performers, electronic music producers and sound engineers that will be built through an 6-day interactive residency with mentor DJs and programmers from SA, Namibia, Zambia and UK. The residency will run from **3 – 8 December 2018** in Lusaka Zambia in partnership with British Council Connect Southern Africa Arts programme.

- Applicants can be aspiring or mid-career female Dj's within the music sector, or work as electronic club or radio dj/performer/music producer/sound engineer/singer age 18 – 35 years.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Applicants can be emerging or mid-career creatives within the music sector, or work as electronic club or radio dj/performer/music producer/sound engineer/singer. We seek to engage artists from electronic music industry. Modzi Arts accepts applicants from around SADC region, with particular attention paid to applicants from Zambia.

Applicants must:

- Applicants can be emerging or mid-career creatives within the music sector.
- Anyone from SADC may apply, but preference will be given to Zambians
- Must be between 18 - 35 years of age and **FEMALES ONLY**.
- Applicants must demonstrate committing to the 6 days.
- Be currently working in the electronic music industry.
- Have a minimum of 6 months experience in the electronic music field

APPLICANTS SHOULD FURTHER:

- Agree that their names and information pertaining to their professional profile may be used for Modzi Arts/Rackless Kazi promotional, marketing and reporting purposes.
- Ensure their availability and commitment to participate in an intensive residency scheduled for the period **Monday 3 to Saturday 8 December 2018** in Lusaka, Zambia.
- Ensure they organize own accommodation and travel expenses, if from outside Lusaka/Zambia. And we have few sponsorship shared accommodation if needed please state in application.
- Ensure they are able to obtain a visa, where necessary, to enter Zambia in time for the commencement of the residency and for its full duration.

ACCEPTANCE

- Shortlisted candidates will be contacted by Friday 23 November 2018. Final selection will be published by Tuesday 27 November 2018.
- Successful candidates must accept and confirm attendance, in writing by Sunday 25 November 2018.
